



2017 Player fees and financial policy

Upon accepting an offer to join one of the Mustangs teams, a **non-refundable \$150 deposit** is required in order to hold your spot on the team. **The deposit is due at the mandatory information meeting. The meeting will be Monday, August 29, 2016 from 6:00pm-8:30pm in the Willow Room at the Laramie County Library.** You may come anytime during the meeting time to fill out player information and consent forms, pick up season information, and pay your deposit. This deposit will be credited to the player's account and will be applied to the player's 2017 team fees.

Player Fees

Fees are as follows and you will be invoiced directly for payment. Players fees are due in full by March 1, 2017. The payments may be paid in two installments with half due by November 30, 2016 and the final half by March 1, 2017.

Player fees must be paid in full by March 1, 2017 or the player will not be allowed to play until fees are paid. This is a board policy.

2017 Fees are:

13U: \$800

Fees include: uniforms, fees for practice facility use, field time, tournament fees, team equipment fees, organizational liability and insurance fees.

14U Prep Team: \$1000

Fees include: uniforms, fees for practice facility use, field time, tournament fees, team equipment fees, organizational liability and insurance fees.

JV: \$1250

Fees include: uniforms, fees for practice facility use, field time, tournament fees, team equipment fees, organizational liability and insurance fees, team transportation to all games.

Varsity: \$1250

Fees include: uniforms, fees for practice facility use, field time, tournament fees, team equipment fees, organizational liability and insurance fees, team transportation to all games.

In order to keep fees as low as we can and to continue to run the organization we must get sponsors and do some additional fundraising during the year. Costs keep increasing for things such as umpire fees, field fees, fuel, uniform costs, and tournament fees. Each player/family will be expected to participate in Mustang fundraising opportunities.

Corporate Sponsorships

The Mustangs organization has community business and individual sponsors who donate each year. We rely on our player families to secure these sponsors. For each sponsor you secure you will receive 25% of the sponsor dollars toward your player fees (up to the total player fee). For example: if you secure a Grand Slam Sponsor at the \$2500 level your player will receive \$625 toward their player fees, if you secure a Triple Sponsor at the \$1000 level you will receive \$250 toward player fees, etc. **You can get up to the total of your player fees credited to your player account through sponsorship contributions. If you pay your fees up front and then get sponsors that also add funds to your player account, any money remaining in the player account over current player fee at the end of the playing season will roll over into the next playing season fees.**

See the attached Sponsor Form. You may make copies of the Sponsor Form to distribute. Please return the completed form along with payment to your coach to receive credit for the sponsorship. Sponsors should be secured as soon as possible- before the end of the year is crucial as most businesses will decide in the fall what donations they will be making for the following year.
