

Cheyenne Mustangs 16U Tournament Rules

- _ BBCOR certified metal or wood bats.
- _ High School Federation Rules apply except as may be specifically modified herein.
- _ Designated hitter allowed for the pitcher only. Teams may bat 10 hitters using one EH. If the EH is used, must bat 10 hitters throughout the entire game.
- _ 7 inning games.
- _ 2 hour time limit on all games except no time limit on the championship game. No new inning will start after 2 hours. In pool play games, if tied after 7 innings or after the 2 hour time has been reached, the teams shall play one more inning. If the game is still tied after one extra inning, the game shall end in a tie. Bracket games will be played until there is a winner.
- _ A starter can re-enter once in his original spot in the batting order.
- _ Each team to supply the plate umpire with 3 new baseballs and 1 used ball at the start of each game. If more are needed, umpires will ask teams for additional balls on an alternating basis.
- _ Teams are responsible for retrieving foul balls on their side.
- _ MUST SLIDE/AVOID CONTACT RULE. Flagrant violation may result in player ejection.
- _ Courtesy runners may be used for the pitcher and catcher. Must be a sub that has not entered game. Same player cannot run for both the pitcher and the catcher in the same game.
- _ Mercy rules: 20 runs after 3 innings; 15 after 4 innings; 10 after 5 innings.
- _ No Pre-game infield unless time permits.
- _ Dead ball balks.
- _ Second mound visit in the same inning, must make a pitching change.
- _ Umpires decisions are final. No protests.
- _ Any coach or player ejected from a game will also be suspended for the following game.
- _ Teams are expected to keep dugouts clean and pick up all trash after games.
- _ There is a gate fee for fans so please inform your fans of that.
- _ **There is a strict City policy of No Seeds, Gum or Tobacco allowed at the fields due to the artificial turf infield. Please help us enforce that policy.**

Any discrepancies in the score will need to be worked out by the two teams comparing their scorebooks. In event of uncertainty, the official book will govern. If an official book is not kept in the score booth, the teams will go book to book, and the home team's book will be considered official. Subs shall be reported to the umpire and the opposing team's scorekeeper. A copy of your lineup will be needed for score booth.

Weather delays will be determined by umpires and site supervisor. All games will resume from the exact place the game was delayed if it was not considered a complete game. 5 innings (or 4-1/2 if home team is ahead) will be considered a complete game. In the event of weather delays, games schedules may change and shorter time limits may be imposed. Weather refunds: None if 2 or more games played; 50% of entry fee if 1 game played; and full refund if no games played.
